Cost Dependent Upon Location and Faculty

## On HS Campus

Taught by HS faculty who are approved as adjunct LCCC instructors

**\$120 per 3-credit course**

## Online

Taught by LCCC faculty but can be completed anywhere

**\$250 per 3-credit course**

## On LCCC Campus

Taught by LCCC faculty at Dedicated Centers or Main Campus

**\$210 per 3-credit course**

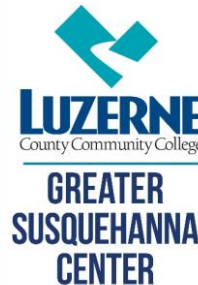
